- Deadline for submitting papers: midnight (Mainland Portugal time) on 1. 30.09.2025.
- 2. Send to: Alexandre de Soveral Martins (soveralm@fd.uc.pt)
- 3. Maximum number of papers selected: 4 (four)
- 4. Character limits for papers: 30,000 characters, including spaces (papers exceeding this limit will not be accepted)
- The character limits do not cover indexes, title pages, abstracts/summaries and 5. keywords, which must be submitted in a separate file
- 6. Graphic presentation criteria: margins: left 3 centimetres; right 1.5 centimetres; top - 1.5 centimetres; bottom - 1.5 centimetres
- 7. Papers must comply with the Editorial Rules of the Legal Institute of the Faculty of University of Coimbra, https://www.uc.pt/fduc/ij/publicacoes/. Papers that do not comply with these rules will not be accepted
- 8. Papers must be sent as Word files and in English
- 9. Selection criteria: Originality of the subject and its relevance, taking into account the theme of the Congress, up-to-date bibliography and knowledge of the sources, relevance of the issues addressed, grounds for the interpretations proposed, coherence of the internal structure of the text and its clarity and correctness, respect for ethical standards in the scientific process
- 10. The results will be: accepted/not accepted
- 11. Accepted papers must be presented in English by the authors in 10-minute speeches (maximum) on the day of the Congress and in accordance with the programme
- 12. The accepted papers will be published together with the studies by other speakers, although the organisers cannot be held responsible for any delay or impediment resulting from the activity of the UCILER
- 13. The authors of the papers accepted for publication waive any copyright for the same.





14. Accepted papers must be presented in person, but UCILER is not responsible for the expenses incurred by the authors for this purpose.
