We need the full and unconditional coming together of all the UCILeR researchers ... that would immediately reflect what we do (and have done) in our CIENCIA VITAE curricula. This does not actually mean that more demanding times await us, but rather it means that the need for participation and delivery is an inescapable dimension of the academic life of all of us... and that it is unforgivable to obliterate it. The UCILeR and the Faculty of Law will not forgive us, we can be sure!



EXHIBITION "LAW AND THE PRINCIPLE OF CONGRUENCE IN THE SCIENCE ERA: THE CENTURY OF HANS ALBERT (1921)"

As part of the XXIV UC Cultural Week, the UCILeR promoted the exhibition "Law and principle of congruence in the science era: the Hans Albert Century (1921)", in the College of Trindade, between March 2-15.

On March 2, the opening combined a conference-debate on the challenge of artificial intelligence and a musical programme with the *Quatour pour la fin du temps* (on the 20th anniversary of Messiaen's death and the 81st anniversary of the quartet's debut in the Stalag VIII concentration camp). The meeting had three sections. The first focused on "The Century of Hans Albert": Think Tank for Critical Rationalism - Dr. Florian Chefai, Dr. Jonas Pöld (Hans-Albert Institut). The second presented "The Century of Messiaen", with the Concert *Quatuor pour la fin du temps*, by Olivier Messiaen - Kaleidoscope Quartet. In the last section, "In the Artificial Intelligence Era", Prof. Christoph Burchard (Goethe-Universität Frankfurt) presented the topic "The Past, Present and Future in Algorithmic Criminal Justice".



Born on February 8, 1921, Hans Albert recently turned 101. Albert's work (in its major dialogue with Popper) and the century that his life has been crossing (which is also the century of the concentration camps in which Messiaen's sublime quartet was created) inspired the exhibition proposed by UCILER and its intense opening session. i. ECI from A to Z Project





The conclusion of the Model ECI, on March 12 in Vigo, wrapped up the first year of the ECI: From A to Z project, coordinated by Dulce Lopes. This was the first in-person activity involving all students from the four partner universities. Before participating in the Model ECI, students developed collaborative work guided by tutors and presented the outcomes in the form of proposals for a European citizenship initiative.

Alexandra Aragão coordinates the UCILeR's project "Research and responsible legal innovation" which aims to develop guidelines aligned to the EU vision on ethics, social cohesion and participation, gender equality, open access and scientific education.

iv. Submission of national and international research projects

The last two months were very productive in relation to project submissions for international and national tenders and funding It highlights the coordination of two applications in the scope of Cluster 2 (Culture, Creativity and Inclusive society), in which the University of Coimbra is the proponent and the UCILeR is the management leader.

The UCILeR submitted the project INTERMILAW – Intercultural Translation, Migrations and Law (HORIZON-CL2-2022-TRANSFORMATIONS-01-03) under the coordination of Ana Gaudêncio and the project EU-COMPASS - EU-COMPASS - Engaging Citizen and COMmunity Participation in Social and Democratic Structures (HORIZON-CL2-2022-DEMOCRACY-01) coordinated by Dulce Lopes. Also in Cluster 2 (HORIZON-CL2-2022-HERITAGE-01-03). Additionally, Mafalda Miranda Barbosa is the UCILeR leader in the collaborative application "IMAge-shaped Europe: A multidisciplinary tool for the monitoring of shared digital images as perceptual sources of values, beliefs, and traditions in a new European strategy for Social Media".

Within the Cluster 6 (Food, Bioeconomy, Natural Resources, Agriculture and Environment), the UCILER is partner in two applications: ArboTrack - Decentralized digital technology for forest management and the wood supply chain, under the leadership of Dulce Lopes, and FAIR NATURE: Transformative Solutions For All, under the leadership of Alexandra Aragão. Finally, at the European level, Alexandra Aragão also participates in the team that submitted the SPIN project – Supporting teachers with pedagogies of environmental education for sustainability to the Erasmus + program.

Regarding to the competition for all scientific domains, the UCILeR collaborated as a partner in two proposals coordinated by the University of Aveiro: RIMA - Regenerate and Innovate in Municipalities through nature, with Dulce Lopes leading the UCILeR team, and ALICE - Air pollution: a stressor for environmental justice, with Alexandra Aragão the UCILeR representative. The UCILeR researchers also coordinated two applications for FCT exploratory projects: ObservAI - Observatory for European and Portuguese Regulation of Artificial Intelligence, with Susana Aires de Sousa as IR, and Ólympos, with Fernando Borges as IR.

Also in national competitions, internal to the University of Coimbra, the UCILER also collaborated with other R&D centres in national competitions such as the Sementes program, the CoastA-DAPT XXI and REPROGRAM projects - fostering inclusive values, policies, and identities through participatory cultural programming in the UC, and led two proposals for the 3rd edition of the Initiative for the Promotion of Scientific Culture, with the projects "Coffee with debate. Artificial Intelligence and Responsibility: the current legal and technical panorama" and "World Cities Day - Right to my city".


v. IVR 2022 Bucharest

1-) Data space for security and law enforcement (DIGITAL-2022-CLOUD-AI-02-SEC-LAW)

This call intends to implement a secure common European space for innovation, enabling research, development, testing, training and validation of algorithms for Al-based systems for security (law enforcement), based on various types of datasets, including sets of anonymous and pseudonymous operational data, following the principle of data minimization.
